Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 108, Section 110 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") read with Rule 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, read with General Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, the General Circular No. 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, the General Circular No. 22/2020 dated June 15, 2020, the General Circular No. 33/2020 dated September 28, 2020, the General Circular No. 39/2020 dated December 31, 2020, General Circular No. 02/2021 dated January 13, 2021, the General Circular No. 10/2021 dated June 23, 2021, the General Circular No. 20/2021 dated December 8, 2021 and the General Circular No. 03/2022 dated May 5, 2022 issued by Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA Circulars"), read with Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and Secretarial Standards on General Meetings (SS-2) including any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force and pursuant to other applicable laws and regulations, that the Resolution appended below is proposed to be passed by the Members of the Company by means of Postal Ballot, only by way of remote electronic voting process ("e-voting").

Pursuant to the MCA Circulars and other applicable laws and regulations, this Postal Ballot Notice is being sent in electronic form only to those Members whose e-mail address is registered with the Depositories/Company/Registrar and Share Transfer Agent (RTA) i.e., Aarthi Consultants Private Limited (“Aarthi Consultants”). The Company has engaged the services of Central Depository Services India Limited (“CDSL”) for providing e-voting to all its members. As the Members are required to cast their votes electronically only, they are requested to read the instructions carefully, as provided in Note No. 12 in the Postal Ballot Notice.

The remote e-voting window shall remain open from 9:00 a.m. (IST) on Saturday, October 22, 2022, till 05:00 p.m. (IST) on Sunday, November 20, 2022, and the remote e-voting shall be disabled thereafter and shall not be allowed beyond the aforesaid date and time. Members are requested to cast their votes on or before the aforesaid date and time to consider the votes as valid.

The Board of Directors of the Company, at their meeting held on Thursday, October 20, 2022, approved the Reclassification of status from “Promoter Group” Category to “Public” Category, subject to the approval of the Members of the Company by way of an Ordinary Resolution.

As required pursuant to Sections 102, 110 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Act, the Explanatory Statement, setting out the material facts concerning the proposed Special Resolutions, is annexed hereto.

The Board of Directors has appointed Mr. G. Vinay Babu, Practicing Company Secretary (Membership No. A20592 and Certificate of Practice No. 20707), as the Scrutinizer for conducting the Postal Ballot through the e-voting process in a fair and transparent manner.

The Scrutinizer will submit his report to the Chairman of the Company, or any person authorized by him after completion of scrutiny of the votes. The results of voting conducted through postal ballot (remote e-voting process only) will be announced by the Chairman or any person authorized by him on or before Tuesday, November 22, 2022. 1. Explanatory Statement pursuant to Sections 102 and 110 of the Act, Secretarial Standards-2 (SS-2) and Listing Regulations stating all material facts and the reasons for the proposed Resolution above, is annexed herewith for your consideration.
2. Pursuant to the guidelines and clarifications issued by Ministry of Corporate Affairs vide General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, 20/2021 dated December 8, 2021 and 03/2022 dated May 5, 2022 (“MCA Circulars”), Companies are allowed to conduct Postal Ballot by sending notice in electronic form only. Accordingly, physical copy of Postal Ballot notice, Postal Ballot form, and pre-paid business reply envelope will not be sent to the Members for this postal ballot. The communication of assent or dissent of the Members would take place through the process of remote e-voting only.
3. In compliance with the aforesaid circulars, this Postal Ballot Notice is being sent only through electronic mode to all the Members whose names appear in the Register of Members/ Record of Depositories **as on Friday, October 14, 2022** (Cut-off date) and whose E-mail addresses are registered with the Depositories/Company/Aarthi Consultants. The Postal Ballot Notice is also made available on the Company’s website at www.virinchi.com and on the website of the Stock Exchange where the shares of the Company have been listed viz., BSE Limited - www.bseindia.com.
4. Members who have not registered their e-mail address are requested to register the same in respect of shares held in electronic form with the Depository through their Depository Participant(s) and in respect of shares held in physical form by writing to the Company’s Registrar and Share Transfer Agent, Aarthi Consultants Private Limited, 1-2-285, Domalguda, Hyderabad - 500029, Telangana State, India i.e., at info@arthiconsultants.com.
5. The voting rights for Equity Shares are one vote per one Equity Share, registered in the name of the members. Voting rights shall be reckoned on the paid-up value of Equity Shares registered in the name of the shareholders **as on Friday, October 14, 2022**. A person who is not a shareholder on the relevant date should treat this notice for information purpose only.

6. In compliance with Sections 108 and 110 of the Act and the rules made there under, the MCA Circulars and Regulation 44 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, the Company has provided the facility to the shareholders to exercise their votes electronically and vote on the resolutions through the e-voting service facility provided by CDSL. The instructions for e-voting are provided in Note No. 12 of this Postal Ballot Notice.
7. Shareholders desiring to exercise their vote through the e-voting process are requested to read the instructions in the Notes under the section ***“Instructions for E-Voting”*** in this Postal Ballot Notice. Shareholders are requested to cast their vote through the e-voting process from 9:00 a.m. (IST) on Saturday, October 22, 2022 to 5:00 p.m. (IST) on Sunday, November 20, 2022 to be eligible for being considered, failing which it will be considered that no response has been received from the shareholder.
8. The Scrutinizer will submit his report to the Chairman after the completion of scrutiny, and the result of the voting by postal ballot through the e-voting process will be announced by the Chairman or any Director of the Company duly authorised, on or before Tuesday, November 22, 2022 and will also be displayed on the website of the Company at www.virinchi.com besides being communicated to the Stock Exchange.
9. The Resolution proposed in the Postal Ballot Notice, if passed by the requisite majority, shall be deemed to have been passed on Sunday, November 20, 2022, the last date specified for receipt of votes through the e-voting process and as if they have been passed at a General Meeting of the Members of the Company.
10. The result of the voting with details of the number of votes cast for and against the Resolution, invalid votes and whether the resolution has been carried or not, along with the Scrutinizer’s report will be displayed for at least three days on the notice board of the Company at the registered office of the Company and on the website of the Company.

12. **The instructions for E-Voting:**
 - a) In view of the threat of Covid-19, the Company is unable to get the Postal Ballot Notice and Form printed and dispatched. The approval of Members is being sought through Remote E-voting only.

- b) You are requested to carefully read the instructions before exercising the vote and complete the E-voting between 9:00 a.m. (IST) on Saturday, October 22, 2022 to 5.00 p.m. (IST) on Sunday, November 20, 2022.
- c) The Company is offering only Remote E-voting facility to its Members to enable them to cast their vote. A Member has to carefully follow the instructions as given for Evoting. He/ She can use the facility and log in any number of times till he/she has voted on the Resolution or till the end of the voting period, whichever is earlier.
- d) Members who have not registered their E-mail ID for receipt of documents in electronic mode under the green initiative of Ministry of Corporate Affairs need to send an email to info@aarthiconsultants.com along with supporting documents and they would get an email with the link to participate in Remote E-voting.

e) Voting through electronic means

In terms of the provisions of Section 108 and Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act) read with Rule 20 and Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (hereinafter called "the Rules" for the purpose of this section of the Notice) and Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 read with General Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, the General Circular No. 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, the General Circular No. 22/2020 dated June 15, 2020, the General Circular No. 33/2020 dated September 28, 2020, the General Circular No. 39/2020 dated December 31, 2020, General Circular No. 02/2021 dated January 13, 2021 the General Circular No. 10/2021 dated June 23, 2021, the General Circular No. 20/2021 dated December 8, 2021 and the General Circular No. 03/2022 dated May 5, 2022 issued by Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA Circulars"), the Company is providing facility to exercise votes on the item of business given in the Notice through electronic voting system only, to members holding shares as on Friday, October 14, 2022 (End of Day) being the Cut-off date fixed for determining voting rights of members, entitled to participate in the E-voting process, through the Evoting platform provided by CDSL.

- f) The voting period begins on 9.00 a.m. (IST) Saturday, October 22, 2022 and ends on 5.00 p.m. (IST) Sunday, November 20, 2022. During this period shareholders of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on Friday, October 14, 2022 the cut-off date (record date) may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.

g) Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. **SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 09, 2020**, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders resolutions.

However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level. Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders. In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to **all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants**. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

h) In terms of **SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020** on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants.
